1. Huts Update – Bethany

• Huts are staying just above water. Very grateful to OHA community for all the help this fall. Greenleaf had to close for two short hitches in order to give their 3 person croo any days off, but we're patching through and with Lakes and Carter closing on Sunday morning and Madison in one week, the end of another good season approaches. We'll be back-filling the remaining huts with the folks from Lakes, Carter and Madison who want to keep working in the huts. Very happy to have had Croo Nights return this year, OHA presence has been good and helpful to current croos with a minimum of self-aggrandizing nostalgia, and we're looking forward to moving to caretaker season and having the small breather of fall before planning for Full-Service 2023 begins.

If so, then YOU know a North Country AMC staff member or a wonderful AMC volunteer who embodies the ideals of Mr. Joseph Brooks Dodge! Huzzah, and please consider nominating them for the 2022 Joe Dodge Award!

2022 marks 100 years since a very young Joe Dodge meandered his way up to Pinkham Notch as lodge crew/all-purpose worker for Milton "Red Mac" MacGregor, the Pinkham & Huts manager of the day. While the Joe Dodge Award is always special and has gone to some remarkable people over the years, it's got an extra kick with the AMC and Joe Dodge having been pals and together keeping folks safe, happy, informed, and entertained in the NH mountains for a century.

Here are the official description and guidelines:

Purpose: To honor and recognize a staff or volunteer member of the AMC White Mountain community who best exemplifies the type of high quality public service that became the hallmark of longtime AMC Huts Manager Joe Dodge's distinguished career at Pinkham Notch. Beyond his commitment to the AMC, Joe showed dedication to the surrounding community through his work as a weather observer, coordinator of search and rescue, and a founding

member of the Mt. Washington Observatory. The award aims to recognize the special ability of Joe Dodge to inspire those working with him: on some occasions it was accomplished by hearty compliment; on others by strongly worded injunction; on still others not by words but by being left alone with the abundantly clear expectation that a mission would be carried out effectively and on time.

Criteria: A nominee may be a current employee, former employee, or volunteer. The essential idea is that the award recognizes the ideals and practices of Joe Dodge and previous award recipients; and the award's existence might stimulate others to strive for consistent excellence into the future. The traits of friendly public service and inspiration to fellow workers are integral to the award and character of Joseph Brooks Dodge, Huts Manager from 1928-1959. Further, the award should focus on actions that relate to AMC activities in the White Mountains - particularly the huts and trails and Pinkham Notch.
