# Secretary's Report (Jared)

Action: Doug made a motion to accept the minutes from the 4/8/25 meeting with edits, Schroeder seconded, unanimously approved.

# Treasurer's Report (AL via email)

We paid our Jackson property taxes, totaling \$882 for this billing period.

AL is still working with Vanguard to fund our account; TD Bank is the hold up now!

We paid for OH t-shirts for all of this summer's croos.

# **Cabin Report (Heather)**

Open Committee Assignments:

- Croo Photo Project: David Burnham is a photographer and has been delving into this. He got Google Doc access from Phoebe, and has been working on paring down duplicate photos. He also photographed everything in the cabin and the Hi-C and digitized them. One takeaway is that we're still missing many hut years. That's the first priority: get a croo photo for every year, think about how this gets displayed (electronically or in print at the cabin), and how to ensure that we have a process for future croos to submit photos... maybe even the same ones they're submitting to Huts Management for the Saturday Truck Update. The group did agree that we would not give cameras to croos, because they would likely get destroyed or unused, as has happened in the past. Stroker will connect David with Becky Fullerton and Kathy Aberdon, and Jared will connect David with Zoe Davidson after September. Once this is complete, David would like to think about how to celebrate the culture and the blending of art and science that characterized the early huts on wall spaces and in talks. More to come!

- Ambassador Program Coordinator: Amanda Henck Schmidt and Bill Barrett, and Jenn Granducci may be, too, in addition to some current croo and YOH Jared has been in touch with.

- Action: Stroker made a motion to nominate Heather Wingate for a 3-year term on the Steering Committee starting in November, Jared second, unanimously approved.
