

## Peter Woodcock obituary

Peter John Woodcock (OH), of Vermontville, NY passed away on October 8, 2023 after a short illness. Nicknamed “Moose” by Huts Manager George Hamilton, Pete worked at Madison in 1960 and on the Construction Crew and was followed in the huts by his brother Steve (OH) who worked on the 1966 Zealand croo. Born in Haverhill MA on January 29, 1942, Peter served in the US Navy during the Viet Nam War as a helicopter pilot who transported Navy Seals on training missions. After working for a number of years in forestry, Peter's career path led him to Westchester County, NY where he served the villages of Scarsdale and Bronxville as a Naturalist and Public Works Superintendent for a total of 37 years.

Having been raised hiking in the White Mountains, Peter was an avid outdoorsman and in later years he loved hiking in the Adirondacks with his wife Julie. When he retired, he and Julie settled in the small town of Vermontville, NY, nestled in the Adirondack Mountains. Peter is survived by his wife Julie, children Rebecca and Adam, stepchildren Teresa, Charles and Christopher, four grandchildren (Gregory, Andrew, Natalie, and Gabriel), three nephews and nieces, and his brother Steve Woodcock.
